Journey Instructions

- Journey instructions
 - At each perch/sephirot or somewhere on each path/channel, collect three specimens as souvenirs of your passing through that part of the world. You should collect one each of vegetable, animal and mineral and place it in the sack or envelope for that perch/sephirot or path/channel.
 - Animal: includes bone, teeth, hair, fur, nails, leather, etc.
 - Vegetable: includes leaves, grass, flowers, bark, soil, etc.
 - Mineral: includes stone, sand, metal, crystal, glass, etc.
 - At each perch/sephirot or somewhere on each path/channel, conduct the activities as outlined in the documents provided.
 - Record at least one observation of yourself
 - an inspiration
 - an emotion
 - a thought
 - a feeling
 - Record at least one observation of the environment around you
 - Energy
 - Visual appearance
 - Words you overheard or read
 - Interactions
 - When you reach Kether, write a brief dispatch about your journey thus far; write no more than two pages. If you need help summarizing, refer to your recorded observations and our discussion framework (What did you discover? What surprised you? What confused you?).
